

**Resolution 2021-4**

**A Resolution Prohibiting or Restricting Open Burning In Perkins County.**

Whereas Perkins County has been impacted by drought conditions of varying degrees and those conditions may worsen throughout the months ahead, in order to protect the public health and safety,

Be It Resolved that the Perkins County Commissioners, pursuant to SDCL 7-8-20(18) hereby adopt a ban to prohibit or restrict open burning in those areas of the County, excluding municipalities as follows:

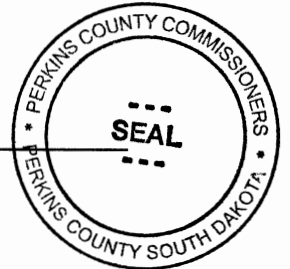
A ban or other restrictions on open burning may be imposed at the discretion of the Perkins County Emergency Manager after consultation with local fire officials and law enforcement officials. Likewise, the Emergency Manager shall have the authority to lift the restrictions or ban upon consultation with local fire officials and law enforcement officials. Notice of the ban or restrictions will be provided to local media, including newspapers and radio stations, and the public may call the Emergency Management Office at 244-5243 regarding the status of open burning restriction in the county.

The County Commission urges all residents and visitors to Perkins County to use common sense and exercise caution with any activities that involve or may cause fires due to dry conditions.



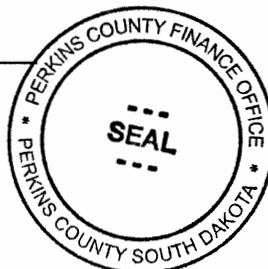
